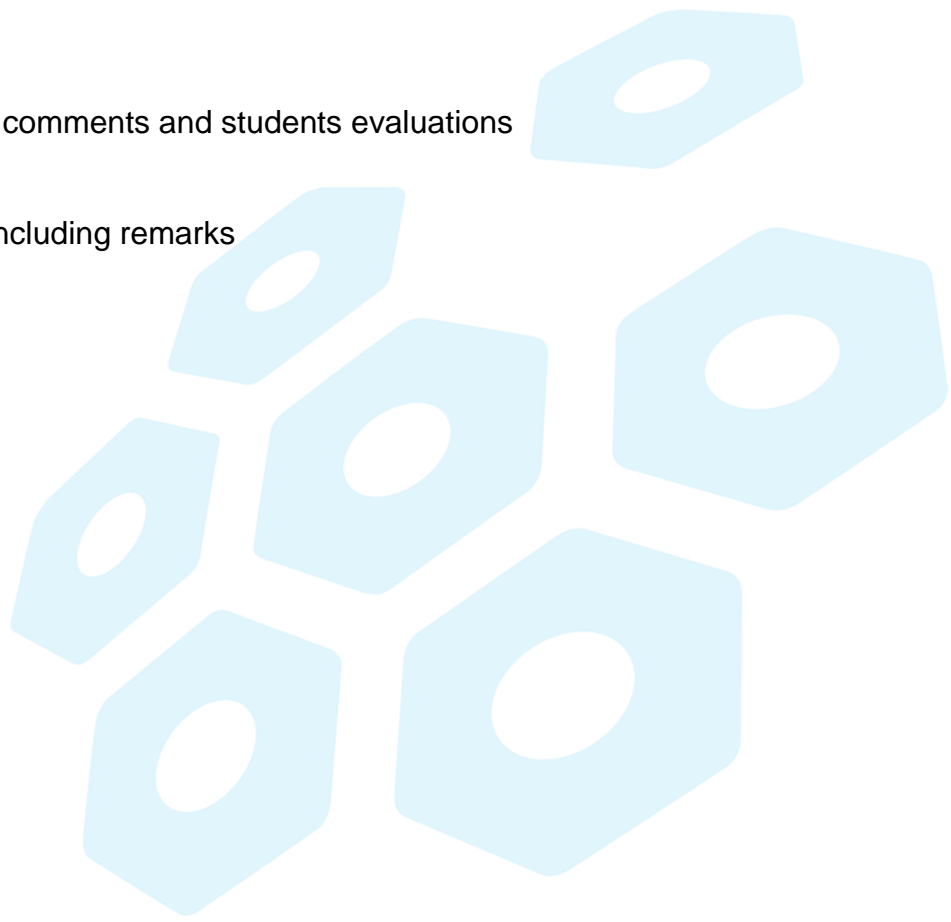

### **Clinical cases:**

**Case 1:** A patient with HCV cirrhosis, naïve for treatment, resected HCC with bad prognostic criteria

**Case 2:** A patient with advanced cirrhosis, severe variceal bleeding and partial portal vein thrombosis, not on beta-blockers, use of early TIPS/Danis stent.

**Case 3:** A patient with cirrhosis, refractory ascites and portal vein thrombosis, AKI and beta-blockers, controversy on anticoagulants, TIPS in refractory ascites

**Case 4:** A patient with ACLF, alcoholic hepatitis, role of liver biopsy, UCI admission criteria, artificial liver support
