- Case 1: A patient with HCV cirrhosis, naïve for treatment, resected HCC with bad prognostic criteria
- Case 2: A patient with advanced cirrhosis, severe variceal bleeding and partial portal vein thrombosis, not on beta-blockers, use of early TIPS/Danis stent
- Case 3: A patient with cirrhosis, refractory ascites and portal vein thrombosis, AKI and beta-blockers, controversy on anticoagulants, TIPS in refractory ascites
- Case 4: A patient with ACLF, alcoholic hepatitis, role of liver biopsy, UCI admission criteria, artificial liver support
